Who can take part?



You must...

✓ Live in the South West or Midlands in England



✓ Be over 18 years old



✓ Not be a student or in fulltime education



✓ Have an idea for a short film



✓ Have made at least <u>one</u> short film in the past

Who can take part?



If you identify as...

✓ Asian, Black, Mixed, Gypsy, Irish Traveller, Mixed or Other ethnic background



✓ Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Queer, Pansexual, Intersex or Asexual



✓ Non-binary or transgender



√ D/deaf or Hard of Hearing



✓ Disabled and/or neurodiverse

We will also ask for details such as your full name, email and access needs.






The deadline for sending us your idea is **Monday 22nd November** at **6pm.**

What happens if my idea is chosen?

If your short film idea is chosen, you will be asked to take part.



New Voices will run from early **December 2021 – April 2022**.

You will get the dates in advance so you can plan around your job, socialising or other plans.



While on the project you will get:

✓ Online training to learn new useful skills.



✓ Mentoring advice from someone with lots of experience in making films.



✓ Help to turn your idea for a 5minute short film into a film
script.

What happens after?

At the end of the New Voices project you will have a finished script for your short film idea.



If your script shows potential then you will be asked to apply to the BFI NETWORK Short Film Funding.



We will match you with a **producer** who will help write your budget and application.



You will need to submit the application to BFI NETWORK Short Film Funding by Monday 2nd May 2022.



Your application to the funding will then be considered by a panel.



BFI NETWORK Short Film Funding is competitive, and we cannot be sure that the film will be selected for funding.
